## Carl Guardino "Projections: Silicon Valley Competitiveness"

It's January, our first meeting of the new year and traditionally the time to pull out the crystal ball to see what's in store for the next 12 months.

This year, our expert takes a particularly Silicon Valley slant to his forecast, which is appropriate. He's **Carl Guardino**, president and CEO of the Silicon Valley Leadership, and keeping tabs on what's going on in the

valley – and what's in store – is his job.

As head of the Leadership Group, a public policy trade association founded in 1978 by David Packard, **Guardino** heads an organization that represents more than 200 of Silicon Valley's top private-sector employers. They collectively provide more than 250,000 jobs here – nearly one of every four – so he has to be on his game.

Before being named president of the Leadership Group, **Guardino** worked for Hewlett-Packard. Known for his efforts at building consensus, his work includes managing the 1996 traffic-relief initiatives known as Measures A & B, and co-managing the 2000 tax-relief initiative often referred to as "the BART tax." He also helped create the Housing Trust Fund, which has raised more than \$31 million in voluntary contributions to help families afford homes in our high-cost valley.

We won't try to predict what he'll say at Wednesday's meeting – predictions are **Guardino's** thing that day. But it is safe to say that we can expect a well-researched speech on important issues. Be sure to have your questions ready.
