All San Jose Rotarians are being invited to provide input regarding our 100 Year Celebration

The Rotary Club of San Jose will celebrate 100 years of service to San Jose and the world between March, 2013 and March, 2014.

There was some discussion under presidents Jerry Silva and Julie Matsushima about how the Club should celebrate this important milestone. President Bert has now asked a steering committee to develop a comprehensive plan for the Club Members to adopt. Dave Sandretto and John Baird are co-chairing this effort.

After being included in last year's membership survey and meeting with the past presidents, the steering committee will now spend the next few months gathering more input directly from Members in the Club.

The survey indicated that our members want this occasion to be much more than just a single black tie event. The potential activities have been divided into four working groups – Awareness, Celebration, History and Legacy. Each working group will be holding meetings to gather input from Members. The first meetings will be in January and are scheduled as follows:

These working groups are open to all San Jose Rotarians and will be gathering information January-April, 2009. Based upon your input, a preliminary plan will be put together and presented first to the past presidents in May and then to both the Club and Endowment Boards in June.

The final plan will be presented to the Club Members for a written vote at the Rotary meeting on Wednesday July 22, 2009.

Webmaster Wanted

The Public Relations Committee has decided to create a new website for San Jose Rotary. We are going to use a popular tool called ClubRunner.

It has been determined that San Jose Rotary needs one person to be our webmaster. This person will be responsible for interfacing with ClubRunner and learning how to maximize the software. This person will also be responsible for working with our committees to post information and photos (Teresa will continue to maintain the Member database and create the Bulletin).

Because the webmaster will need to learn the software and then set-up pages for all of our committees as well as for other generic Rotary information, the San Jose Rotary webmaster will be paid a one-time set-up stipend of \$2,500.

Starting in April, 2009 (sooner if possible) the webmaster will be responsible for posting changes and new information to these pages as requested by other Rotarians. Understanding that this will take 15-20 hours each month, the San Jose Rotary webmaster will be paid a monthly stipend of \$500.

We are looking for someone who is willing to do this important job for at least two years.
