Chris Block "Ending Homelessness"

Every night, far too many men, women and children are homeless in Silicon Valley – and many more are at risk of becoming homeless.

Our speaker is an effective advocate for people who are homeless and a nationally-known speaker on affordable housing issues for more than 20 years. **Chris Block** is the Executive Director of Charities Housing Development Corporation, and a member of the Executive Committee of Destination: Home,

a public-private community initiative that is implementing the recommendations of 2007's Blue Ribbon Commission on Ending Homelessness and Solving the Affordable Housing Crisis in Santa Clara County.

Chris will speak next week about our community's effort to end homelessness, and the roles we all must play to achieve that worthy goal.

Come to the Gordon House rose garden on Saturday, January 24th and learn everything you need to know about having a great year with your roses. Our Rosarian Rotarian, Joel Deceuster will be on hand from 8:45AM till noon leading Rotary volunteers in the pruning and winterizing of the 120+ rose bushes that surround the Gordon House. This is your opportunity to learn from the expert and apply his secrets for having your best year yet with your own rose garden. Starting at 8:45AM we'll have coffee and Greenlee Bakery's world famous fresh baked cinnamon bread. Enjoy mixing with fellow Rotarians while Joel sharpens and sterilizes your rose clippers. At 9AM Joel will give a pruning demonstration and show us how to tip and spray our roses to protect



them from overwintering diseases and insects. He'll also demonstrate how to plant bare root roses with recommendations for those that grow really well in our San Jose climate. Members of the Santa Clara Rose Society will also be on hand to answer questions and give advice as they help us with this pruning



marathon. All those who sign up in advance will be directed to online pruning demonstration videos produced by the Friends of the San Jose Rose Garden.

We had a great first year at our Gordon House rose garden but 2009 is bound to be our best year yet. This garden brings a lot of joy to those who visit our headquarters and History San Jose. Come for as long or little as you can. You don't need to be an experienced pruner. We'll turn you into one.
