Dr. Kathryn Barrett-Gaines "African AIDS Orphans"



Kathryn Barrett-Gaines is Director of African American Studies at the University of Maryland Eastern Shore, where she is also an Assistant Professor of History. However, ten years ago, she was a doctoral candidate at Stanford University and applied for and received a *Rotary Ambassadorial Scholarship*, enabling her to conduct research in Uganda and East Africa for her Ph.D. degree. She also has an M.A. in Cultural Anthropology from Duke University and an M.A. in African American Studies from the University of Maryland Baltimore County.

During **Kathryn's** two year academic study time in Uganda (Fulbright for second year) she encountered a language teacher at the university who started a school where she volunteered as an instructor. Stemming from this 1997 encounter, our Rotary club began a working relationship, which over the years has become one of our ongoing international projects supporting this primary school called the Zinunula Omunaku Educational Center, AKA, ZOEC. For instance this year, twenty AIDS orphaned children received SJRC tuition scholarships so they could go to school for one year. Still to come is a water collection system; last year, class room furniture was built.

Since 1997, **Kathryn** has lived off and on in Uganda, where she has been a stage and recording artist in Lugandan language musical entertainment, a newspaper columnist, a radio/ TV host, and worked at the National University of Rwanda and Makerere University in Uganda. She also taught high school and elementary school in her home town of Washington, DC.
