# **Dr. David Adamson** "Fertility Solutions"

Having children is one of life's great joys. For some couples getting pregnant can be a challenge. Dr. David Adamson is a Clinical Professor at Stanford University School of Medicine. He is President-elect of the American Society for Reproductive Medicine. He has published over 100 peer reviewed articles on reproductive medicine and surgery, endometriosis, infertility, and the assisted reproductive technologies. He was recognized by Good Housekeeping Magazine as one of the best 400 physicians for women in America. In 1997, Dr. Adamson founded Advanced Reproductive Care, Inc.,



a national network of physicians in 40 states that perform one third of all in vitro fertilization services in the United States.

# JOB SHADOW DAY 2008

What is Job Shadow? Students will spend part of the day in the workplace "shadowing" employees through a normal day on the job.

When is the event? Rotarians are encouraged to participate on Wednesday, March 12, 2008, culminating the day by bringing 2 of your students to the weekly Rotary meeting.

What do I do with the students when they arrive? JA will provide a Workplace Coordinator's Guide that contains suggestions that will help you plan a successful day. This guide includes a suggested agenda and easy to do activities.

How many students can participate? 2 to 30 students depending on the size of your company/organization – you choose. This year we will be collaborating with the Interact Clubs that are affiliated with the San Jose Rotary to place students, and our goal is to find opportunities for at least 100 students.

How do I sign up? Fax or email a copy of the Registration Form to the JA office by February 13th and JA will identify students for your site and put you in touch with the school coordinator.

#### Why should I participate?

- A need exists to connect the world of school and the world of work.
- Many high school students don't have opportunities to explore various career options.
- The day takes young people into the workplace to find out what skills and education might be needed in the work-world of tomorrow.
- A study by Kravis Leadership Institute in Southern California shows that students who job shadow are more likely to finish high school and obtain a four-year degree.
