

Wesley J. Smith "Bioethics and Assisted Suicide"

Rotary is pleased to present this week award winning author and lawyer Wesley J. Smith. Mr. Smith has written or co-authored eleven books on a variety of topics from: consumer protection; to the role of corporate lawyers in American justice; to the truth about airline safety. An updated revision of his classic anti-euthanasia book published in 2006 is entitled: "Forced Exit: Euthanasia, Assisted Suicide, and the New Duty to Die." In another of his books entitled "Smith's Consumer's Guide to a Brave New World," published in 2005, he explored the morality, science, and business aspects of human cloning. Smith's web log "Secondhand Smoke" which defends the unique



moral value and importance of human life is read by thousands of readers worldwide. In May 2004, because of his work on bioethics, he was named by the National Journal as one of the nation's top expert thinkers in bioengineering. Come with your questions.


This new version brings the valley history up to date, including the dot-com boom, bust and recovery, and a PBS documentary narrated by Leonard Nimoy is being planned about the book.
