Chief Scott Seaman has been the Chief of Los Gatos/Monte Sereno Police Department since July 2002. Prior to that time, Chief Seaman served 27 years in the San Jose Police Department. Over the course of his career, Chief Seaman has worked a wide variety of assignments including Patrol, Special Operations, Investigations, Narcotics, Community Services and Personnel and Training.

Since his appointment as Chief, the Los Gatos/Monte Sereno Police Department has received three awards for excellence in community policing including the 2004 International Association of Chiefs of Police and 2006 James . Wilson

Community Policing Awards.

Chief Seaman holds a B.A. in Criminology from the University of California Berkley and a M.S. in Management from Cal Poly Pomona. He is a graduate of the 207th FBI National Academy and the California Law Enforcement Command College.

John Hopkins was born in Watsonville in 1932, and went through high school there. He attended Stanford for 7 years graduating with a B.A. in 1954 and J.D. in 1957. John has been practicing law since 1957.

On January 1, 1960 he came to San Jose where he now practices tax and estate planning. In 1968 John helped found Hopkins & Carley.

He is married to his wife Valerie and has 3 children now living and 3 step children. John has been active in many community organizations and joined Rotary in 1997.

Following the successful **FIRESIDES REDUX** in October, we will once more offer Firesides over the course of a week. Our goal is to have a minimum of 12 events. Of course, based on demand, we can accommodate any number of additional events. Please let me know if you would like to host an April Fireside. Here are the guidelines:

- 1. All events must include at least 2 new members Red Badgers (0-1 year) and/or New Blue Badgers (1-2 years) but to encourage "mingling" new members are not eligible to host an event. Hosts are free to find their own new members to invite or the Fireside Committee will assign them.
- 2. Events can be hosted by 1 or 2 members and held any weekday evening or anytime on Saturday and Sundays of that week. The format is up to the host(s) e.g. sit-down dinner, after-work social, potluck or catered, weekend brunch or afternoon BBQ.
- 3. The Fireside Committee will coordinate all sites and keep a running list of individual event attendees and available "slots". Sign-ups for events will be on a first come-first served basis. Anyone who is interested in an event with no openings will be given the option of being put on a wait-list for the event or given their choice of another event.

In October we had 9 sites and a total of 105 participants - 65 Rotarians (only 15% of membership) and 40 Spouses and Guests. We can do better than that! Please consider signing up to host an event and one of our committee members will get back to you with more details. 
