Brian Michael Jenkins

“Mineta Transportation Institute’s National Security Center Director”

Brian Michael Jenkins is the director of the Mineta Transportation Institute’s National Transportation Security Center and one of the world’s leading authorities on terrorism and sophisticated crime. He works with government agencies, international organizations and multinational corporations as an analyst, investigator, and crisis management consultant. From 1989 to 1998, **Mr. Jenkins** was the Deputy Chairman of Kroll Associates, an international investigative and consulting firm. Before that, he was chairman of RAND’s political science department, where from 1972 to 1989, he also directed RAND’s research on political violence.



Besides his UCLA degrees, **Mr. Jenkins** studied at the University of Guanajuato in Mexico and in the Department of Humanities at the University of San Carlos in Guatemala where he was a Fulbright Fellow and recipient of a second fellowship from the Organization of American States.
