Stacy Castle **"YWCA Childcare Centers"**

Stacy Castle was appointed Director of Childcare for the YWCA of Silicon Valley in 2005 following two years as the YWCA's Director of Parent Education. Under her supervision and direction are seven YWCA Childcare centers located in low- to moderate-income areas. These childcare centers provide quality subsidized and affordable childcare to more than 500 children each year. The YWCA's childcare program has been serving families for 60 years throughout the Silicon Valley.

In her role as Director, **Stacy** hires, supervises, mentors, and manages a staff of 40+ employees including site directors, teachers and aids. She manages and directs a budget of \$2 million and is responsible for program compliance as mandated by Santa Clara County and state of California guidelines and regulations. **Stacy** directs and collaborates on all aspects of the Childcare Center's program and resource funding, including contracts, grants, and other fundraising efforts in support of the seven YWCA of Silicon Valley Childcare Centers.

Stacy is a leader in our community for issues pertaining to children. In this role, she currently serves as a member of the Santa Clara County Child Abuse Council, the Student Education Needs Committee in Santa Clara County, The Santa Clara County After School Collaborative, and the Children's Health and Fitness Coalition of Santa Clara County. In addition, she has served as a FIRST 5 panelist for the West Region and maintains a high profile as an expert on matters of Childcare Services and Parent Education.

Stacy maintains an active family life, balancing her professional demands as Director of Childcare with her husband and four children. **Stacy** passionately embodies the YWCA of Silicon Valley's Childcare mission: "It's all about the kids!"
