Kim Campbell "Operation Enduring Freedom and Iraqi Freedom"

Captain Kim Campbell has flown over 100 combat missions in Iraq and Afghanistan.

In April 2003, Captain Campbell flew missions over Baghdad, providing close air support for troops on the ground. On one of those missions, her A-10 Warthog took a direct hit from a surface-to-air missile.

With a large chunk of her plane shot away, the plane riddled with holes from shrapnel, and the hydraulic system disabled and on fire, Captain Campbell had to regain control of her aircraft over Baghdad while still

being shot at by Iraqi forces on the ground. Reverting to manual flight controls (pulleys and cables), she successfully kept her A-10 from crashing. After an hour of struggling with her wounded aircraft, she landed successfully in Kuwait to the applause of her ground crew.

It was a mission for which she was awarded the Distinguished Flying Cross for, in the words of the Commander of the Air Combat Command, her "outstanding heroism and selfless devotion to duty."

Captain Campbell is the daughter of San Jose Councilmember Chuck Reed and Paula Reed.

Captain Campbell is a 1993 graduate of Piedmont Hills High School in the East Side Union High School District.


