Isaak Egge has worked for Heifer International as the Northwest Community Relations Coordinator since September 2002. Tasked with raising money and awareness throughout the Pacific Northwest, **Isaak** manages a network of regional volunteers, assists in the development of fundraising and educational activities and speaks on a regular basis to churches, schools, foundations and civic clubs about Heifer's work and the role Americans can play in the fight against global hunger and poverty. He has spent time in several Heifer project sites including Uganda, Rwanda, Thailand, Honduras, El Salvador and Southern United States.

Prior to joining Heifer, **Isaak** worked as a United States Peace Corps volunteer, serving two and a half years in Saint Vincent (a small West Indian island) followed by five months as a Crisis Corps volunteer in Southern Belize.

Isaak received his Bachelors degree in International Relations from California State University, Long Beach and a Masters degree in Community Development from University of California, Davis.

Isaak is a life-long resident of California: born and raised in Sonoma County and currently residing in Sacramento.

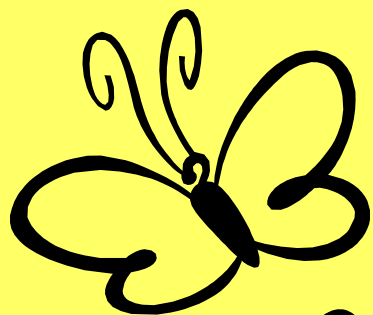

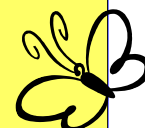
