## **Benjamin Powell**

Immigration: As A Path to International & Domestic Development. "Making Poor Nations Rich"

Formerly at San Jose State, Benjamin Powell is now an assistant professor of economics at Suffolk University and a senior economist with the Beacon Hill Institute, both in Boston. Furthermore, he is a Research Fellow with the Independent Institute of Oakland, CA. He earned his B.S. in economics and finance from the University of Massachusetts at Lowell, and his M.A. and Ph.D. in economics from George Mason University.

Professor Powell is author of more than 30 scholarly articles and policy studies. His primary fields of research are economic development, Austrian economics, public choice, and housing economics. Dr. Powell's research findings have been reported in more than 100 popular press outlets including the *Wall Street Journal* and the *New York Times*. He also writes frequently for the popular press. His popular writing has appeared in the *Investor's Business Daily*, the *Financial Times* (London), the *Christian Science Monitor*, and many regional outlets. He has appeared on numerous national and regional radio and television shows including, *CNN*, *MSNBC*, *Showtime*, and *National Public Radio*.
