## **Dan Keegan**

### **“The Hole in the Donut-Building a Destination Urban Center”**

**Dan Keegan** is the Executive Director of the San Jose Museum of Art since 2000 and was the former director of the Kemper Museum of Contemporary Art in Kansas City, MO. He has twenty-three years of experience in higher education as an educator and administrator. Since coming to San Jose, **Dan** has led a team that has more than doubled attendance of the Museum, produced exhibitions that have achieved national acclaim, and acquired major works of art for the Museum's collection.

Working with leaders of the Region, City of San Jose, the Museum's board of trustees and the San Jose Convention Center, **Dan** is examining the potential to develop a major museum expansion in downtown San Jose as part of a larger initiative to establish a vision for the future of San Jose's creative urban center...and execute on that plan.

**Dan** will discuss the initiatives underway for downtown San Jose, the role destination experiences play in competitive communities and the economic viability of destination urban centers and how they are developed.

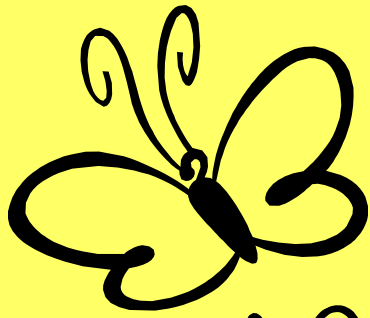
