This weeks "Rotarian of the Week" recipient was Brian Allen

Brian Allen joined Rotary in 1982 and was sponsored by Glenn George. He has participated in Enterprise Leadership Conference and is an Executive Chef.

But Brian's "Rotary Passion" has been Rotary Fish since its inception in 1995. This committee has held 12 annual events and has hosted in excess of 3,000 third graders from urban schools with Washington School participating in all 12. Rotarians give their time to share their knowledge and love of fishing with these kids.

"Fishing in the City" is now sponsored by 8 additional South Bay Rotary Clubs. This event has also become a national model, which Brian co-chairs. More than 300,000 kids have participated from Hawaii to Alaska, to Florida and Ladysmith Wisconsin Brian's home town.
