

From 101 North or South ~ Merge onto Hwy. 880 heading north and continue following the directions below.

From 880 North or South ~ Exit on E. Brokaw Road, continue heading East. Cross Old Oakland Road. In less than 1/2 mile, turn right on Deluca Drive, then turn right onto Sajak Ave. and another right on Missions Springs Circle and a final right turn onto Mission Springs Court. (Murphy I backs up to Murphy Ave. between Ringwood and Deluca Dr. but there is no access from Murphy Ave.)
