## **Rotary Personals** **With Don Callahan and Art Carmichael**

**Don** is a "double dip" Rotarian: in the Campbell club for ten years and its President in 1969-70, and has been a member of our club for thirteen years where he has served as a Director from 1999-2002. He is a very active member of the Membership Involvement Committee among other Rotary service.

A native of New York, **Don** has been a Californian since childhood, and schooled in Los Gatos. After Air Force service he studied at Golden Gate University where he was Student Body President, and then entered on his career in accounting. He was a CPA for more than thirty years and since 2003 has been associated with his son, Kenn, in the Callahan Riordan Real Estate Group.

**Don** has served on more than a dozen boards and community groups, ranging from arts groups to youth service groups and has received many, many awards. Notably the 2002 John D. Crummy Award which is the highest award given by the YMCA of Santa Clara Valley.

This is a real life of service and it will be instructive and entertaining to learn more about the personal side of a man who has done so much good.

A fourth-generation San Josean, **Art Carmichael's** family has a long history as business and community leaders in the Bay Area, which **Art** has successfully continued. His great-grandfather was a gold miner and became a storekeeper in San Jose in 1851. One of his grandfathers was a vintner, and the Cribari winery he founded still bears his name. The other was a police and fire commissioner in San Jose during the 1906 earthquake, and his father was director of the U.S. Mint in San Francisco.



**Art's** path took him from Bellarmine College Preparatory to the University of Oregon, but he returned to the Bay Area where he worked for Royal Insurance Company before joining Flamer & Company Insurance Brokers in 1966. With **Art** as its president, Flamer & Company grew from five to 65 employees and merged with Corroon & Black in 1988. He left his position as chairman of Willis Corroon in Silicon Valley in May 1999 to form Valley Global Insurance Brokers, which merged with CBIZ in 2006. He and his wife, Jean, live in Los Altos and have two children.
