Dan Rusanowsky "San Jose Sharks"

Dan Rusanowsky Radio Play-by-Play Announcer for the San Jose Sharks is a 28-year veteran of hockey broadcasting. He is responsible for producing all radio broadcasts, and directs and administers the multi-station Sharks Radio Network. Along with his broadcasting duties, **Dan** works with many community organizations and is an active member of the NHL Broadcaster's Association.

On November 25, 2000 **Rusanowsky** was injured in a serious automobile accident, which ended a continuous broadcast streak of Sharks regular season and playoff games at 774. He called his historic 1,000th Sharks regular season game on March 21, 2004 vs. Edmonton.

Before arriving in the Bay Area, **Dan** was the radio voice for the American Hockey League's New Haven Nighthawks (1986-91) and St. Lawrence University's NCAA Division I hockey program from 1979-86. He received a bachelor's degree at St. Lawrence and subsequently earned his M.B.A. at Clarkson University.

In less than 1/2 mile, turn right on Deluca Drive, then turn right onto Sajak Ave. and another right on Missions Springs Circle and a final right turn onto Mission Springs Court. (Murphy I backs up to Murphy Ave. between Ringwood and Deluca Dr. but there is no access from Murphy Ave.)
