Warren Hegg "Stories of Service and Stories of the Fallen"

The Digital Clubhouse Network (DCN) was created by NASA in 1996 "to develop innovative ways of using technology to build a better community."

For the past ten years, the DCN has operated Digital Clubhouses in Silicon Valley and New York City, and has developed a series of

award-winning demonstration projects that have attracted international recognition.

The "operating system" of the Digital Clubhouse is the Digital Abled Producers Project (D@PP), a unique vouth leadership program for teens and pre-teens that is based in part on the Rotary model of service.

At today's Rotary meeting, D@PPers from the Silicon Valley Digital Clubhouse in the History Park in downtown San Jose will present examples of two of their current projects:

- * Stories of Service, a national initiative that is helping 100,000 teachers to mobilize students to document the lives of America's Greatest Generation (www.stories-of-service.org) in partnership with The History Channel.
- * Stories of the Fallen a project to assist Gold Star Families create a "virtual memorial" to honor those who sacrified their lives in the war in Iraq.

In keeping with a Fourth of July theme these programs will remind us all that freedom is never free and that

sometimes the price of freedom is the ultimate sacrifice.


