## Rolanda Pierre Dixon "Domestic Violence"

Domestic violence affects all segments of our society and community. The overall welfare of families and the psychological state of mind of the parent and child are a major concern for us all. Domestic violence also affects many areas of legal Practice, criminal law, civil law and family law to name a few.

Rolanda Pierre Dixon is an Assistant Deputy District Attorney for Santa Clara County and is the county's expert on domestic violence. **Ms. Pierre Dixon** is a graduate of San Jose State University with a BA in Political Science. She received her JD from the University of Santa Clara in 1980. She has handled all types of criminal prosecution; including drunk driving, assault and battery, robbery, juvenile and domestic violence.

**Rolanda** established the first domestic violence unit in Santa Clara County in 1991 and was the supervisor of the unit until January 2006 when she was promoted to Assistant District Attorney. She now supervises the Family Violence Unit which includes domestic violence, child abuse, physical elder abuse and child abduction. In this capacity the unit members have prosecuted over 5,000 domestic violence cases per year and are considered to be one of the premiere units in California. **Rolanda** also supervises the Dependency Unit and all training for the Santa Clara County District Attorney's Office. She also chairs the Santa Clara County Death Review Team and has since its inception in 1994.

Santa Clara County's Death Review Team was one of the first in the nation and its yearly reports are requested nationwide. **Ms. Pierre Dixon** has presented on the formation of domestic violence units, domestic violence prosecution, victim advocacy and death review in over 15 states and all over California. She trains prosecutors, law enforcement officers, victim advocates, medical professionals, students and the public at large. She is currently the Assistant District Attorney in charge of the Family Violence Unit, Dependency and Training for the Santa Clara County Office of the District Attorney.
