Congresswoman **Zoe Lofgren**, well known for her work in patent and immigration reform, will give us an update on her congressional work. She is serving her seventh term in Congress representing most of the City of San Jose and Santa Clara County. She serves as Chair of the House Judiciary Subcommittee on Immigration, Citizenship, Refugees, Border Security, and International Law. She also Chairs the House Administration Subcomittee on



Elections and serves on the very important House Homeland Security Committee. Congresswoman **Lofgren** is Chair of the California Democratic Congressional Delegation consisting of 34 Democratic members of the U.S. House of Representatives from California.

Following her time on the board of Supervisors from 1981-94, **Zoe** was elected as the only freshman Democrat west of the Rocky Mountains. Before that she was the staff assistant to her predecessor Congressman Don Edwards 1970-78 and taught immigration law at Santa Clara University. She is married to John Marshall Collins and has two children.


