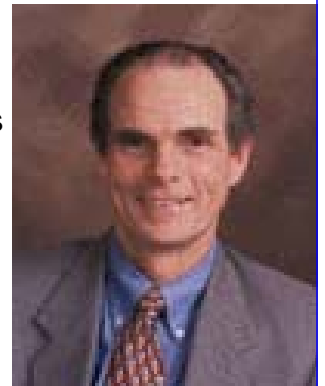


Mayoral Debate With Cindy Chavez & Chuck Reed
