Jackie Speier "This Is Not The Life I Ordered"

Jackie Speier served in the California State Legislature for 18 years, rising to Assistant Pro Tem of the State Senate and Chair of Committees on Banking, Finance and Insurance, and Government Oversight. Previously Speier served 6 years on the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors. She ran her first statewide race, for Lieutenant Governor, in 2006 and lost by just 3% of the vote. She gained national attention in 1978 as legal counsel to Congressman Leo Ryan, accompanying him on an ill-fated trip to Guyana to investigate Jim Jones and the People's Temple. Ryan was assassinated and Speier shot 5 times.

Jackie is a co-author of the recent bestselling book, *This is Not the Life I Ordered* and recently joined the law firm of Hanson Bridgett in San Francisco.




