Tom Bowen **"A Culture of Champions"**



Tom Bowen was named San Jose State University's Director of Intercollegiate Athletics in December 2004. Under his leadership and with his vision, San Jose State has established itself as a viable Division 1-A intercollegiate athletics program from both a talent and fundraising perspective. **Bowen** came to SJSU after having served three years as Director of Community Affairs for the San Francisco 49ers. He has served in similar positions at the University of California at Berkeley, Saint Mary's College and De La Salle High School in Concord, California.

A 1983 graduate of the University of Notre Dame he played high school football at Moreau High School in Haywood. An active member of the Bay Area community, he serves on the Board of San Jose Sports Authority. **Tom** is an adjunct professor at the University of San Francisco School of Sports Management and at SJSU's Department of Kinesiology. At the core of his mission for the University's athletics program is building a "Culture of Champions" academically, athletically, and in the community. To that end he has made significant changes to the department and its infrastructure. In 2006-07, the University football team capped its finest season in two decades, posting a 9-4 overall record and capturing the New Mexico Bowl championship.
