Rotarian Of The Week ~ Don MacMillan

The purpose of the Rotarian of the Week is to put a face on what it means to be a true Rotarian and to inspire all of us to strive to be better Rotarians and to ask that person to share why they are so involved in our Rotary Club.

This weeks "Rotarian of the Week" recipient was Don MacMillan.

Don became a Rotarian in 1981. He has been active in the Downtown Committee since 1984. He was also the Rotary Golf Chairman from 1993 to 2003 and served on the Rotary Board 1998-2001.

In May 1998 he started working with other Rotarians to find a new Rotary luncheon facility with Terry Graff. In February, 2000 he started to work with the San Jose Redevelopment Agency to get the Rotary Summit Center banquet facilities approved by the City of San Jose Council. He monitored the banquet faculties design with Pierre Prodis to make sure the quality of the project would be first class. In 2002, Don was on a committee to work with Terry Graff to raise \$1,000,000 for the Rotary Center and personally



contributed \$50,000 toward the project. Don developed the contributor plaque which is now installed in the Joe Levitt Room.

Starting in 2002, Don worked with Carl Cilker, Jim Eller and Shirley Lewis to get agreement from the City of San Jose on the Banquet Facilities Agreement and Contribute Funds Agreement which was signed in May 2003. He also started dialogue with the Redevelopment Agency on the outside sign in January 2002 culminating in the sign installation in November 2006. This includes working with the City on a new Sign Ordinance on Fourth Street, working with the Planning Department to approve the sign. With Rich Truempler's assistance, they worked on pricing out the various components of the sign and finding how to erect the sign when the City had no as built plans.

Don worked with Carl, Jim and Shirley to negotiate a new agreement with the Fairmont Hotel in 2005. He was instrumental in getting the Banquet podium lights in 2005 for fee, thanks to Mike Blach's effort.

One of Don's pleasure was having the opportunity to work with 10 Rotary Presidents who assisted in getting the job done. They are Terry Graff, Mary Ann Diridon, Randy Hall, Gary Giannini, Mel Matsushima, Carl Cilker, Skip Franich, Kay Walker, Dick Campisi and Jerry Silva. He also enjoyed working with many Rotarians on the project that he would not have had the opportunity to meet otherwise.
