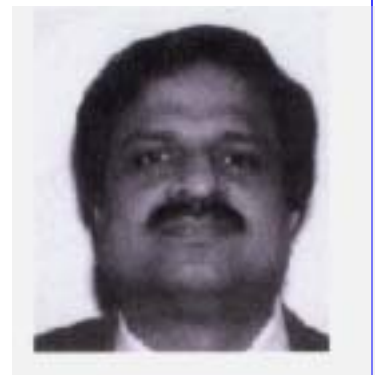
Rotarian Of The Week ~ Ramesh Hariharan

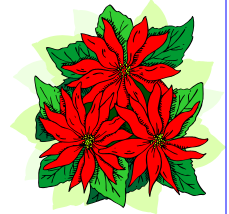
