## Larry Gerston "Election 2006"

A regular speaker at Rotary who we ask back again and again, **Larry Gerston** will share his insights after a long election night on TV and radio.

A professor of political science at San Jose State University, **Larry Gerston** examines the public policy process at the national and state levels. His *Public Policy making in a Democratic Society: A Guide to Civic Engagement* (2002) has been heralded as a breakthrough in "hands on" citizen/service learning partnerships. His ninth and newest book is *Recall! California's Political Earthquake* (with Terry Christensen).

**Gerston** is the political analyst at NBC11 and at radio station KCBS. He writes "Up Front", a monthly column in *San Jose Magazine*, and has penned more than 80 op-ed columns in newspapers including the *San Jose Mercury News*, *San Francisco* 

Chronicle and the Los Angeles Times. He has also appeared on NBC Nightly News, BBC, and CNN's Inside Politics.

A sought after motivational speaker, **Professor Gerston** gives several talks each year for the "We the People...Project Citizen" programs sponsored by the Center for Civic education. He has a unique ability to put complex issues into an understandable context.
