
This weeks Rotarian of the Week recipient was Rod Diridon.

Rod Diridon chaired the San Jose Rotary Program and Classification Committees and founded and chaired for 9 years the new Membership Development Committee.

He has sponsored nearly 100 new Rotarians, 9 in one year when he won the "Mike Kutsuris District Membership Development Award". His annual "Rotary tithe" has resulted in 11 Paul Harris Fellowships and 5 San Jose Endowment Fellowships.

Rod has served several times in District leadership positions, and has attended many district conferences being asked often to make membership development

and retention presentations. The "Rotary Club of San Jose Integrated Membership Strategic Action Plan" developed by Rod won the Rotary International innovative program award for 2005/2006.

Deliver Wheelchairs to Viet Nam in March 2007

In July, District 5170 Rotarians were asked to participate in the National Immunization Day in Ghana and attend the West Africa Project Fair in October. We took approximately 100 Rotarians and spouses, from 25 different Rotary districts, and 59 Rotary clubs. Over a five day period, we participated in the Project Fair and delivered Polio drops and Vitamin A drops to the children of Ghana. It was an extraordinary experience, filled with emotion, purpose and tremendous International fellowship.

Another opportunity is now available for your club. As a Rotarian, you can change the lives of people in your community and throughout the world. Involvement in Rotary gives the ordinary Rotarian extraordinary opportunities to do things that they could never do unless they were in Rotary.

In March 2007, Rotarians will travel to Vietnam for 14 days to deliver approximately 280 wheelchairs. In addition to the delivery of wheelchairs, we will spend time, seeing the beautiful country of Vietnam. A wonderful part of this process is that the Rotarians can put someone into a chair and see how they respond as their life is changed. We invite the members of your club to join us.

To be clear, we are not asking for funding. These wheelchairs have already been purchased. We are only asking you to take a trip of a lifetime, and represent your club.

The program includes airfare, hotels, transfers, special events, and a donation of one wheelchair. Many Rotarians have already joined us, and remaining space is limited. Our website has also been updated to include the information about this tour. Go to: HowardTours.com.
