The recent Tax Extenders and Alternative Minimum Tax Relief Act of 2008 allows certain individuals to take tax free distributions from Traditional and Roth IRA's if they are distributed directly to charities. Basically, the mandatory distribution goes to a designated charity without any tax due from the individual. You may want to consider The Rotary Foundation (International) or the Rotary Club of San Jose Endowment (local) for your charitable donation.
